## Press release

On July 1, 2019, in conclusion of the respective hearing session, the Independent Qualification Commission decided on the confirmation in duty of the subject of re-evaluation, Mr.Artan Madani, prosecutor /head of the Prosecution Office in the First Instance Court, Kavajë.

Today, on July 29, 2019, the International Monitoring Operation, has submitted to the Public Commissioners the recommendation to appeal to the Appeal Chamber the decision of the Independent Qualification Commission for re-evaluation subject, Mr. Artan Madani.

The Public Commissioner, after being notified of the written decision of the Independent Qualification Commission, shall review it in addition to the recommendation of the International Monitoring Operation.

This decision has not yet been notified.

Referring to point 7, Article 55, of law no.84 / 2016 "On the Transitional Re-evaluation of Judges and Prosecutors in the Republic of Albania", the Independent Qualification Commission within 30 days shall notify the written decision to the Public Commissioners.

Based on point 1, Article 63, of law no.84/2016 of the Regulation "On the Transitional Reevaluation of Judges and Prosecutors in the Republic of Albania", the Institution of Public Commissioners, has the right to appeal the decision of the Independent Qualification Commission to the Appeal Chamber, within 15 days as of the notification.
